WASTEWATER DEPARTMENT 6" VOLUTE SUBMERSIBLE PUMP Flygt model NP-3153.185 with 460 Volt /3 Phase/60 Hz 20 HP 1750 RPM motor; 433 impeller; 1 x 50 Ft. length of SUBCAB 4G16+S (2x0,5) submersible cable, FLS leakage detector, MINI-CASII/FUS 120/24VAC,24VDC; 11 Pin octal din mount socket; prepared for flush valve.
