REPORTS:

DPW: Report presented. Quote for pump & pipe submitted for Well #4 on Sports Ave. Needs to start looking at big pipes in downtown, look into engineer studies to change storm drain pipes.

Paving complete now just waiting for County to paint lines on the roadway now. Still trimming when time.

Zoning: Report presented. Water issue on Elm Street side of trailer park, Don Chapin is looking into fixing the situation. Bill is aware of the camper on Grove Street and is working on that situation. Working with owners of the News Block buildings for a use variance on the property.

Second inspection done at the beach with a flawless report. 2,500 people in July and more still coming in the month of August. Recently received donations of paddle boards, peddle boats and a kayak from Hannawah community. County workers were great. Last day August 27, 2023. Mile swim went well for another year. Lots of compliments this whole beach season. Possible look into internet for the Beach.
